## **Assistant Chief Kyle Levar**

Assistant Chief Kyle Levar has been serving the District since January of 2013 rising from the rank of Firefighter/EMT to Lieutenant in July of 2015 and then Captain in January of 2022 and lastly promoting to Assistant Chief in 2023. AC Levar has responded on over 380 calls during his time with Beulah Fire and received a letter of commendation for his command of the North Creek Floods of 2017. AC Levar is a certified EMT, Wildland Firefighter I, Structure Firefighter I, HazMat Operations, and a technical rescue specialist. Here is a little more about AC Levar in his own words.



We have lived in the valley since 2015, and within Beulah's district since I was 3 or so. I grew up most all my life here in Beulah area on the family ranch. My parents grew up in pueblo county, and my Wife (Jennifer) grew up mainly in Rye. I am currently a technician at Beulah-Land Communications. I do everything from installing fiber (buried plant) to fixing phone lines and working with fixed wireless networks. Jennifer and I have been married for a little over 24 years, have two boys Dylan who is 24 and Peyton who is 21, both boys still live in Beulah. Jennifer works from home currently doing health care orders and insurance verification. Dylan is currently on Beulah Fire full time as a FF/EMT and mitigation specialist. Peyton is an equipment operator for Colorado Crushing and has been going on for 3 years as well as we all still help run our family ranch running 110 plus cow-calf pairs on average. I was recruited by Kurt Thompson back in 2012, and officially came on in 2013 when we became a district. I have volunteered a few times in the past with the all-volunteer department and always enjoyed it. When I joined, I suppose it was to help my community or a pass the torch kind of idea, as a lot of the older volunteers had retired. I am extremely proud of how far we have come as a department from the new building, newer equipment, training and our abilities, adding young members as well as our working relationships with all of the surrounding city/county agencies.
