### **MINUTES**

Also in attendance was FF/EMT+ Hunter Richardson representing Chief Bryan Ware who was absent. No Community members were present.

### 1. CALL TO ORDER.

## 2. APPROVAL OF OCTOBER AGENDA.

## 4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 25TH, 2025, MEETING.

#### 5. FINANCIAL REPORT

The current balances in the operating account and the savings balance will be provided at a later date. Reviewing the reports provided, all expenses and incomes for the month were within the normal budget.

#### 6. CHIEF'S REPORT, written by Bryan Ware and reported by Hunter Richardson

• As of Tuesday, we are at 238 calls for service with 131 of those being EMS and 91 transports. The remaining 107 calls have been for fire/rescue. We are currently 25 calls ahead of last year's run volume.

- We will be starting our winter EMT Academy on November 4<sup>th</sup>. We currently have 15 registered participants, with 3 of them being Beulah members.
- Dylan and Michelle recently completed the State Primary Instructor Course for EMS.
- The new rescue stabilization kit from the State Fire grant has been received and has been placed in service.
- We have completed our smoke permit application with the State to stay compliant with the smoke requirements. No issues are foreseen impeding the permit process.
  - No citizens have filed complaints with the District nor with the State. The
    complaints came from a staff member and a parent from the school who both live
    outside of Beulah.

#### 7. OLD BUSINESS

- a. CWDG Grant Review
  - 1. We are still waiting on CSU to issue payment for our September expenses. That dollar amount is \$ 150,237.
    - i. Forrest Tree Service had to stop work due to no payment yet; as soon as we receive payment, we will pay them.
    - ii. We are moving forward with a revolving line of credit with Bank of the San Juans for \$200,000; no ETA on completion of that process.

#### 8. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Hiring Firefighter/EMT-IV Contract
  - 1. Hunter Richardson has been offered the position as a full-time Firefighter/EMT-IV with the caveat of paramedic school being completed in the next two years. Hunter had the highest accumulated score of the application process and accepted the position.
- b. Combined Nov/Dec Meetings Advance Notice
  - 1. December 7, 2025, at 1 pm there will be an Executive Session as per Section 24-6-402(4)(f) C.R.S. for a personnel matter, to conduct Beulah Fire Protection and Ambulance District Chief Bryan Ware's Annual Performance Review
  - 2. December 11, 2025, at 6:30 pm there will be a Combined Nov/Dec Meeting to discuss the Proposed 2026 budget.
